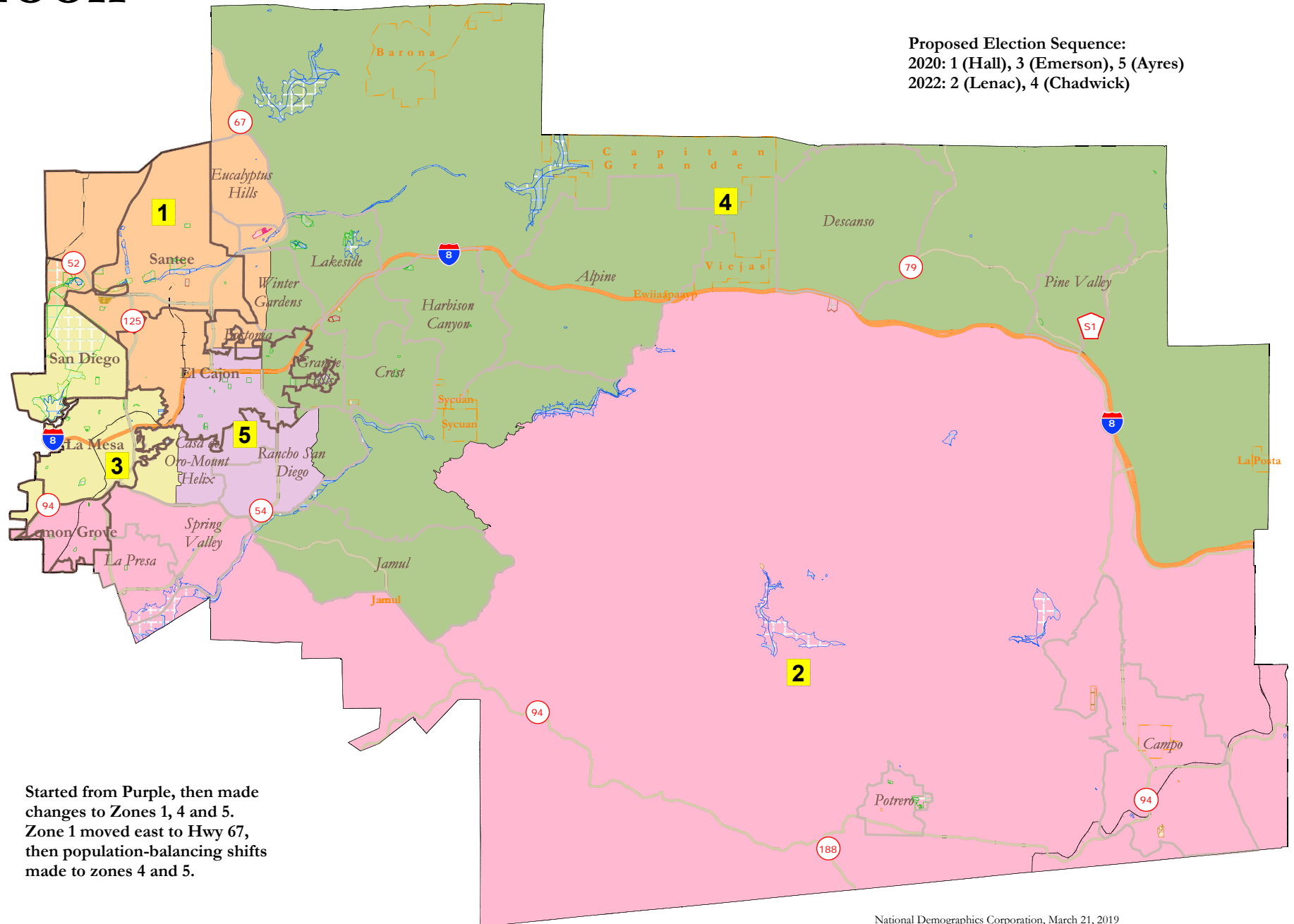


Maroon
